Construction Contracts

- 1. Informal Bidding Requirements Less than \$500,000, no minimum number of bids required.
- 2. Licensed General Contractor required for all contracts in excess of \$30,000.
- 3. If project exceeds \$300,000, then performance and payment bond required on all contracts in excess of \$50,000.
- 4. Design professionals required:
 - a. If project exceeds \$300,000 and do not include any major structural change in framing or foundation support systems,
 - b. If project exceeds \$100,000 for repair of public buildings affecting life safety systems,
 - c. If project exceeds \$135,000 and includes major structural change in framing or foundation support systems,
 - d. If project exceeds \$135,000 for the construction of, or addition to, public buildings.

- e. Design professionals must be selected based on
 "demonstrated competence and qualification" without regard to fee other than unit price services.
- f. Local governments may "in writing exempt particular projects" when projected fee is less than \$30,000 or in the sole discretion of the unit stating the reasons therefore and circumstances attendant thereof.
- 5. Formal Bidding Requirements
 - a. Project estimated to cost \$500,000 or more
 - b. Advertising for Bids
 - c. Three bids required for construction or repair contracts in the formal range.
 - d. 5% bid deposit required.
 - e. Bid award to the "lowest responsible bidder, or bidders."
 - f. All contracts must be in writing.
- 6. Methods of Contracting
 - a. Separate prime bidding
 - b. Single prime bidding
 - c. Dual bidding
 - d. Construction management at risk
 - e. Design/Build
