RESOLUTION OF THE JACKSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ESTABLISHING CASHIERS-GLENVILLE FIRE SERVICE DISTRICT

WHEREAS, Chapter 153A-301 of the North Carolina General Statutes authorizes counties within North Carolina to define service districts in order to finance, provide, or maintain for the districts one or more of the following services, facilities and functions in addition to or to a greater extent those finances, provided or maintained for the entire county; and

WHEREAS, said statutes further provide that the county may define a service district for the purpose of fire protection; and

WHEREAS, the Cashiers-Glenville Fire Insurance District lies within the boundaries of Jackson County; and

WHEREAS, on May 7, 2015 the Board of Commissioners of the County of Jackson approved the boundary lines of the Cashiers-Glenville Fire Insurance District in accordance with the maps and descriptions filed said date with the Board of County Commissioners and recorded in the minutes of said meeting; and

WHEREAS, the existing rural protection district is no longer needed as the Jackson County Board of Commissioners will create a new fire service district to fund the cost of fire protection service through an individual service district tax levy; and

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Commissioners agree to proceed with a proposal to abolish the existing rural fire protection district within Jackson County, and to create a new fire service district within the Cashiers-Glenville Fire Insurance District; and

WHEREAS, notice of public hearing for the creation of such Fire Service District has been provided by publication of notice of hearing and also provided by U.S. mail to the owners as shown by the County tax record of all property with the proposed fire service district and that such public hearing has been conducted;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF

THE COUNTY OF JACKSON does hereby support the Cashiers-Glenville Fire Department, Inc. in its endeavor to establish a Fire Service District.
