Chairman Debnam called the public hearing to order and stated the purpose is to receive public comment concerning Jackson County entering into a financing agreement pursuant to N.C.G.S. 160A-20 for the Smoky Mountain High School Gymnasium and Performing Arts Center project in the amount of \$10 million. The loan will be for a term of 15 years at annual interest rate not to exceed 2.79 percent.
