Chairman Debnam called the public hearing to order and stated the purpose of the public hearing was to solicit public input for the proposed Scattered Site Housing Rehabilitation Project to be submitted by Jackson County to the NC Department of Commerce, Division of Community Assistance for the Community Development Block Grant Program. Jackson County's proposal is for \$225,000 to be utilized for home rehabilitation and urgent repair on a scattered site basis

Gerald Green, Planning Director, stated the funds will be used for rehabilitation of four or five low income homes at an estimated allocation of \$50,000 per home; however, there is the possibility additional homes may be added. It will be early spring before the grant will be awarded.
