The purpose of the hearing is to receive public comment concerning Jackson County entering into refinancing agreements to reduce interest rates for the following loans:

1. Bank of America (Cashiers/Webster/FV-K Project) drop from 3.72% to 2.29%.
2. Bank of America (Dept on Aging Project) drop from 4.35% to 2.46%.
3. SunTrust (Solid Waste Project) drop from 4.54% to 2.46%.
