**MINUTES OF A PUBLIC HEARING
OF THE JACKSON COUNTY
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
HELD ON
NOVEMBER 19, 2012**

The Jackson County Board of Commissioners held a Public Hearing on November 19, 2012, at 5:45 p.m., Justice & Administration Building, Room A201, 401 Grindstaff Cove Road, Sylva, North Carolina.

Chairman Debnam called the public hearing to order and stated the purpose of the Public Hearing is to receive public input on a proposed Elderly and Disabled Operating and Capital 5310 Program Grant to be submitted to the N. C. Dept. of Transportation.

Chuck Norris, Transit Director, stated the funding is for a 2 year budget (FY 13-15). A 50% local match is required but the county can leverage the match by using funds from the EDTAP program and other contract income. Based on the ability to do this, the county will only be responsible for the 10% match required for the Mobility Coordinator. The estimated breakdown of the 5310 grant request including the required local match is as follows:
