**MINUTES OF A PUBLIC HEARING

The Jackson County Board of Commissioners held a Public Hearing on October 21, 2013, at 5:50 p.m., Justice & Administration Building, Room A201, 401 Grindstaff Cove Road, Sylva, North Carolina.

Chairman Debnam called the public hearing to order and stated the purpose is to receive public input on a proposed amendment to the Cashiers Commercial Area Development Ordinance.

Gerald Green, Planning Director, stated the Cashiers Area Planning Council, the Planning Board, and the Planning Department staff recommend adoption of the following amendment reducing the number of members on the Cashiers Area Community Planning Council from 10 regular members with 2 alternates to 7 regular members.

Sec. 3-2. Cashiers Area Community Planning Council.

b. Membership; terms; vacancies.

(1) The Cashiers Area Community Planning Council shall consist of 7 regular members appointed by the Jackson County Board of Commissioners. All members shall be residents of, own property in, and/or own a business in the Cashiers Commercial Area.

(2) All members shall serve 3-year terms. All members shall serve a maximum of 2 consecutive terms. Terms of initial appointments shall be staggered as set forth

(3) Vacancies shall be filled by the Jackson County Board of Commissioners.

Public Comments: None

There being no public comments, Commissioner Elders moved to adjourn the public hearing. Commissioner Greene seconded the Motion. Motion carried by unanimous vote and the hearing adjourned.
