

**MINUTES OF A PUBLIC HEARING
OF THE JACKSON COUNTY
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
HELD ON
NOVEMBER 4, 2013**

The Jackson County Board of Commissioners held a Public Hearing on November 4, 2013, at 1:45 p.m., Justice & Administration Building, Room A201, 401 Grindstaff Cove Road, Sylva, North Carolina.

Chairman Debnam called the public hearing to order and stated the purpose was to receive public input on a proposed Community Transportation Program grant application to be submitted to the N. C. Dept. of Transportation.

Chuck Norris, Transit Dept. Director, stated the grant is recurring and is applied for annually. 85% of the director and administrative assistant salaries and fringes are reimbursable from these funds as well as 85% of all administrative costs such as office supplies, drug and alcohol testing, uniforms and marketing. 90% funding of all capital purchases are included as well. An estimated breakdown of this year's grant request, including the required local match, are:
