Chairman Debnam called the public hearing to order and stated the purpose is to receive public input on a 2014 Justice Assistance Grant application submitted by the Sheriff's Dept.

Major Shannon Queen stated the funds will be used to improve the internal safety and security of the Sheriff's Office by increasing the use of electronic locks, lock monitoring and card swipe systems. The total grant is \$10,219 and allocated \$9,197.10 for equipment and \$1,021.90 administration fees. No local funds or Board action are required.
