

**MINUTES OF A PUBLIC HEARING

The Jackson County Board of Commissioners held a Public Hearing on November 03, 2014, at 1:55 p.m., Justice & Administration Building, Room A201, 401 Grindstaff Cove Road, Sylva, North Carolina.

Chairman Debnam called the public hearing to order and stated the purpose was to receive public input on a proposed Community Transportation Program grant application to be submitted to the NCDOT.

Chuck Norris, Transit Department Director, stated the 5311 grant is recurring and is applied for annually. 85% of the director and administrative assistant salaries and fringes are reimbursable from these funds as well as 85% of all administrative costs such as office supplies, drug and alcohol testing, uniforms and marketing. 90% funding of all capital purchases are included as well. An estimated breakdown of this year's grant request, including the required local match, are:
