**MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING
OF THE JACKSON COUNTY
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
HELD ON
APRIL 4, 2005**

The Jackson County Board of Commissioners held a Public Hearing on Monday, April 4, 2005, at 6:00 p.m. in the Boardroom, Justice & Administration Building, 401 Grindstaff Cove Road, Sylva, North Carolina.

Chairman McMahan called the public hearing to order and stated the purpose is to discuss a change in treatment of some units for the county's existing Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program known as the Jackson County Scattered Sites Project (CDBG 03-C-1128).

Joan Stillwell, Community Development Director, reported that some units are beyond repair and not eligible for rehabilitation. She recommended that the budget be amended as follows:
