Chairman Debnam called the public hearing to order and stated the purpose of the public hearing is to solicit public input for a \$600,000 Community Development Block Grant for Mountain Projects, Inc. to acquire property owned by REACH of Jackson County to be used for affordable rental units for low/moderate income residents. .

Patsy Dowling, Director, stated it is the intent of Mountain Projects to maintain the property for its original intent of domestic violence housing followed by income criteria residents. A full application will be submitted in early June but will probably not be awarded for approximately five months. Mountain Projects will begin managing the property effective June 1 using resources from the NC Housing Finance Agency.
