**MINUTES OF A PUBLIC HEARING
OF THE JACKSON COUNTY

The Jackson County Board of Commissioners held a Public Hearing on May 2, 2011 at 1:30 p.m, Justice & Administration Building, Room A201, 401 Grindstaff Cove Road, Sylva, North Carolina.

Chairman Debnam called the public hearing to order and stated the purpose of the public hearing is to solicit public input for a Community Development Block Grant in the amount of \$500,000 for clearance and re-construction of four single-family dwellings that are owner occupied with low incomes.

Joan Stillwell, Community Development Director, stated the funds will be used for four clearance/rehabilitation/reconstruction projects. The budget is \$450,000 for the program and \$50,000 for grant administration. The homes will remain at low to moderate income levels for a period of ten years.
