**MINUTES OF A PUBLIC HEARING

Chairman McMahan called the public hearing to order and stated the purpose is to receive public comment concerning the close out of the Community Development Block Grant Program, 2006 Scattered Site Housing Program.

Joan Stillwell, Community Development Director, reported the following:
06-C-1531 Grant Funds – completed six houses, four clearance and relocation activities (replacements), and two rehabilitation activities with C1 grant funds. Seven low to moderate income, single-family, owner occupied houses were assisted. Grant funds were allocated as follows:

<u>Administration</u>	\$ 40,000.00
<u>Rehabilitation</u>	\$ 70,908.20
<u>Relocation</u>	\$353,289.46
<u>Clearance</u>	\$ 35,500.00
<u>L1 Funds</u> – one rehabilitation project	
<u>Rehabilitation</u>	\$ 302.34
<u>TOTAL</u>	<u>\$500,000.00</u>
