(1) 441 CORRIDOR STEERING COMMITTEE APPOINTMENT: Commissioner Cowan moved to appoint Jason Lambert in lieu of Barry Weldon who is unable to serve. Commissioner Shelton seconded the Motion. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

(2) 441 CORRIDOR PLANNING STUDY: Matt Noonkester and Michael Rutkowski of Kimley-Horn & Associates presented an overview of what the US 441 Corridor Study will entail. A proposed vision statement along with identification of issues will be submitted at a later date. The planning process will include a study area boundary, data exchange, present baseline conditions, public design charrette, implementation strategies, and draft/final document. They will meet with the Steering Committee later today.
