**MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING
OF THE JACKSON COUNTY
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
HELD ON
AUGUST 7, 2008**

The Jackson County Board of Commissioners held a Public Hearing on, August 7, 2008, at 5:45 p.m. in Room A201, Justice & Administration Building, 401 Grindstaff Cove Road, Sylva, North Carolina.

Chairman McMahan called the public hearing to order and stated the purpose is to receive public comment concerning the Scattered Site Housing Program including the description of the proposed project, project location, activities to be carried out, total cost of activities, and financial design.

Joan Stillwell, Community Development Director, stated that the county is receiving an additional \$100,000 grant to be utilized for one house relocation (\$90,000) and clearance activities (\$10,000). One low-income homeowner will be served through this additional program funding. She plans on constructing a stick-built house. The site is located on Keener Cemetery Road in Sylva.

There being no public comments, Commissioner Shelton moved that the public hearing be adjourned. Commissioner Cowan seconded the Motion. Motion carried.
