**MINUTES OF A PUBLIC HEARING

Chairman Debnam called the public hearing to order and stated the purpose is to receive public input on the proposed FY2011-12 Budget and opened the floor for public comment.

Public Comments:

(1) Mary Otto-Selzer, on behalf of the Friends of the Library and all volunteers, expressed appreciation to the Board for providing sufficient funds in the proposed budget so the current level of hours of service (45 per week) can be maintained. She also requested a strong level of funding continue for the Albert-Carlton Library.

(2) Carl Iobst of Cullowhee stated the Board should carefully consider “needs vs. wants” of projects before the budget is adopted due to the economy.

There being no further public comments, Commissioner Elders moved that the public hearing be adjourned. Commissioner Cody seconded the Motion. Motion carried.
