County Manager's Report

The following information is provided:

1. License Plate Agency

The new Jackson County License Plate Agency, "Tag Office", opened to the public at approximately 9:45 am on Tuesday, March 26, 2024. There were some technical difficulties that prevented credit/debit card transactions on Tuesday. But they were fully operational on Wednesday and Thursday. In its first three days there were 404 transactions processed totaling \$42,016.59 and they collected \$187.00 in notary fees.

A Facebook post made by Tiffany Henry, Director of Economic Development, resulted in 117 reactions, 28 comments, and 207 shares. All the comments were positive and appreciative of the County for continuing this service.



The location of the office is Skyland Services Center, 876 Skyland Drive, Sylva, NC 28779.

2. Animal Shelter Building

The Old Animal Shelter building located at 463 Airport Road can be used for a storage building for the Jackson County Recreation and Parks Department. This will free up storage space currently being used by the Recreation Department in the Sylva location. The Maintenance Department would then be able to utilize the space freed up.

3. Jackson County Aquatics Center – Field Report from 3/21/24 is attached.

The Jackson County Aquatics Center has an anticipated completion date of July 27, 2024.

4. Center for Domestic Peace

The contract to RE Crawford has been reviewed by both parties. RE Crawford has signed the contract. The Certificate of Insurance has been issued and the notice to proceed will be issued this week.

5. Fontana Regional Library Agreement

The attorneys from Jackson and Swain Counties are meeting next week. Information will be provided to the Board following that meeting.

6. Qualla-Whitter Park and Cashiers Splash Pad

The Qualla-Whittier Park is about two weeks behind schedule due to working out some details on the water/sewer routing through the property and a couple items related to utilities.

Permits for this project are much simpler and will not slow the project down further.

The Cashiers Splash Pad will go out for bids in April barring no setbacks on permits.

The Stormwater Management Permit Application was completed today.

We are placing signs at the sites for Qualla-Whittier Park and the Cashiers Splash Pad.


- See notes from previous field reports for any items that have not been closed out.
- Roof expansion joint: area of recess at existing roof was patched with decking. GC to send photos of decking installation and fastening for structural review. Via email we sent feedback that insulation at this piece of deck needs to be installed. Spray foam insulation underneath decking is an option, but questions remain if this can be retro-actively installed.
- Kalwall installation: as noted in email exchange: ensure that flashing wraps from sill up into jamb conditions. Kalwall battens to align with curtainwall mullions as best as possible.











Kalwall - Sill flashing and bottom track installation
