The purpose of this memo is to request to hold a public hearing for the FY24 Community Transportation Program Grant Applications on September 20, 2022 at 12:55 pm. A joint public hearing is acceptable for both community transportation program grant applications. As the applicant, Jackson County Transit will be seeking permission to apply for the Public Transportation Program funding, enter into agreement with the North Carolina Department of Transportation, provide the necessary assurances and the required local match.

The 5311 Administrative grant program helps to subsidize the administrative costs of running a transportation system which includes administrative salaries and benefits as well as office supplies, uniforms, training and marketing.

The 5310 Operating grant program supports transportation operating costs for the elderly and individuals with disabilities.

WHEREAS, the purpose of these transportation funds is to provide grant monies to local agencies for the provision of rural, small urban, and urban public transportation services consistent with the policy requirements of each funding source for planning, community and agency involvement, service design, service alternatives, training and conference participation, reporting and other requirements (drug and alcohol testing policy and program, disadvantaged business enterprise program, and fully allocated costs analysis); and

WHEREAS, the funds applied for may be Administrative, Operating, Planning, or Capital funds and will have different percentages of federal, state, and local funds.

WHEREAS, non-Community Transportation applicants may apply for funding for "purchase-of-service" projects under the Capital Purchase of Service budget, Section 5310 program.
