

## ORDINANCE DECLARING TRAFFIC REGULATION AND HAYRIDE FOR A YOUTH ARTS FESTIVAL

**WHEREAS**, the Jackson County Commissioners acknowledge a long-standing tradition of providing an annual Youth Arts Festival and transportation for the event (hayride); and

**WHEREAS**, the Jackson County Commissioners acknowledge a community benefit from holding an annual Youth Arts Festival and transportation for the event (hayride); and

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Commissioners acknowledge traffic regulation and a hayride requires approximately two (2) hours to install signing and traffic control, and requires approximately two (2) hours for removing signs, traffic control and litter.

**NOW THEREFORE,** be it resolved by the Jackson County Commissioners, pursuant to the authority granted by G.S. 20-169, do hereby declare to temporarily regulate traffic, but not close to traffic, by means of traffic or semaphores or other signaling devices on any portion of the highway where traffic is heavy or continuous during the day(s) and times set forth below on the following described portion of a State Highway System route:

**Date:** Saturday, September 20, 2025

**Times:** 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

**Route Description:** WBI Drive, Haywood Road (SR 1514),

and Green Energy Park Road (SR 1539)

This ordinance to become effective when signs are erected giving notices of the special limits and times of the event and implementation of minimal traffic control to protect participants on the event route.
