Who We Are: A nonprofit community park system at the heart of Cashiers.

Our History: Serving the community for 30+ years as a gathering place for residents and visitors.

What We Do:

- Maintain 13+ acres of green space, gardens, trails, and event spaces.
- Venue for over 275 days of community events annually

 concerts, festivals, educational programs, and family
 gatherings.
- Provide free, public park access year-round for all ages.

Our Role: The only community green space and affordable event campus in the area, making us a vital hub for recreation, culture, and connection.

Why Year-Round Restrooms Matter

- TVG has the **only public restrooms** available in our community.
- Hundreds of families, residents, and visitors utilize the restrooms monthly.
- TVG has over **35,000 visitors** in our park annually.
- Restrooms are **used 275+ days** a year for community events.
- Access for all Restrooms support families with young children and older adults, helping everyone enjoy the park longer.
- Year-round public facilities encourage late fall/winter events and tourism.
- Public Restrooms = safety, comfort, and hospitality for families and visitors.



Current Restrooms & Challenges










- Not insulated which means there are no restrooms open November – May
- 20+ years old
- Deteriorating and damaged interiors
- Hard to clean (wood interior paneling)
- Only two toilets and two sinks for over 35,000 annual visitors

- Safer, cleaner, and more hygenic environment for all




- Supports local businesses by encouraging visitors to stay longer
