

eRECORDING

As of November 19, 2015, the Jackson County Register of Deeds office is accepting all documents, EXCEPT plats, for electronic recording (eRecording). ***** ***Beginning November 1, 2023, our office is also accepting Plats for electronic recording.*** *****

The hours for eRecording are 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except holidays. All deeds are sent electronically to the Land Record's office automatically. So please allow longer time frames to e-record deeds, up to 24 hours.

REQUIREMENTS TO BECOME AN AUTHORIZED SUBMITTER:

Financial and legal companies, attorneys, title companies, etc. that would be interested in becoming authorized submitters will need to contact one of the following authorized providers:

Upon selecting an authorized provider, the submitting company will need to complete the Submitter Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) which is required to submit documents electronically with our office.

REQUIREMENTS TO BECOME AN AUTHORIZED PROVIDER:
