Duties also include replacing bulbs and paper supplies, watering plants, trash collection, sweep and clean snow/ice from sidewalks, lock and unlock buildings, move furniture, and set up of meeting rooms. Scheduled work is completed during an 8 hour evening shift that typically begins between at 3 or 4 pm, Monday – Friday.
