

CAPITAL RESERVE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, there is a need in Jackson County to construct safety upgrades for the Public Schools;

WHEREAS, the Public School facility safety needs have been assessed to determine the upgrades needed at each facility;

WHEREAS, the Jackson County School Safety needs have been assessed by McMillian, Pazdan, Smith Architecture at an estimated cost of \$7,409,447.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BOARD THAT:

- Section 1. The Governing Board hereby appropriates \$3,400,000, from the School Capital Fund 19 and \$4,009,447 from the School Capital Reserve Fund 21 for said construction.
- Section 2. The Board does hereby authorize the transfer of \$7,409,447 from the School Capital Reserve Funds to the Capital Projects Fund.
- Section 3. This resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
