



CAPITAL RESERVE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, there is a need in Jackson County to renovate the building for the Cashiers Code Enforcement Office; and

WHEREAS, the facility and office space needs of the Cashiers Code Enforcement Office located at 357 Frank Allen Road, Cashiers, NC has been assessed; and

WHEREAS, the renovation of the building located in Cashiers has been assessed, reviewed, and designed by Mahaley Odell Thompson, AIA at an estimated cost of \$212,000.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BOARD THAT:

Section 1. The Governing Board hereby appropriates \$212,000 from the capital reserve fund for said renovation.

Section 2. The Board does hereby authorize the transfer of \$212,000 from the capital reserve fund to the Capital Projects fund.

Section 3. This resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
