AGREEMENT: Attached to this email is the TVA Ag & Forestry Fund Agreement. Please review the information carefully, print out 2 copies, sign and mail with a completed W-9 to the address below. Make sure the signatures on the agreement include the Director, Board Chair or Manager of your office and the individual responsible for the project. Once the originals are received we will sign and mail an original back to you for your file.

PAYMENT & REPORTING FORMS: Two forms are attached to this email, one is for payment and the other is the financial report form to be used with your quarterly report narrative. Both forms reflect the budget conveyed in the proposal. Please review the information on the financial report form to make sure it is accurate. Be sure to update the matching and in-kind information as needed for the quarterly reports.

If you are ready to receive payment, the TVAAF Pay or Reimburse Form should be completed, signed and mailed in with the Agreement and W-9 to receive the first/initial payment of your grant. This same form can also be used to request payments/reimbursements during the grant cycle.

Expenses against this grant can start May 15, 2015 and must end before or by June 1, 2016.

EQUIPMENT: You have an equipment grant, so you can request up to 95% of the funds for the first/initial payment. Be sure to include a quote or appropriate documentation with the request. The

quote will need to be replaced with the actual receipt/invoice to close out the file at the end of the grant cycle.

NON PROFITS: Be sure to include the two completed certification documents Conflict of Interest and No Overdue Tax Debts with the 2 signed agreements and W-9.
