



**RESOLUTION OF
THE JACKSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
DELEGATING LEASING AUTHORITY TO MANAGER**

WHEREAS, Jackson County owns various parcels of property; and

WHEREAS, North Carolina General Statute §160A-272 authorizes the Board of Commissioners to delegate to the county manager the authority to lease such parcels for periods of up to one year;

THEREFORE, the Board of Commissioners of Jackson County resolves that:

1. The county manager is authorized to enter into leases of county-owned parcels for periods of up to one year, upon such terms and conditions as the manager shall determine.
2. The county manager shall report to the Board of Commissioners at the first meeting of each quarter as to any leases of county-owned property entered into during the preceding quarter.
