## MINUTES OF A RECONVENED WORK SESSION OF THE JACKSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS HELD ON JUNE 11, 2018

The Jackson County Board of Commissioners met in a reconvened Budget Work Session on June 11, 2018, 1:00 p.m., Justice and Administration Building, Room A201, 401 Grindstaff Cove Road, Sylva, North Carolina.

Chairman McMahan called the meeting to order.

Mr. Adams provided the FY2018-2019 Budget Changes. This was a summary of all items that had been discussed and how to address the vast majority of the issues. They discussed paying off the Qualla building and the Balsam building. Darlene Fox, Finance Director, proposed to pay both off in the current fiscal year.

Ms. Fox stated that the Qualla building loan was with BB&T with an interest rate of 3.97% and a balance of \$150,091. The Balsam building loan was with HomeTrust Bank with an interest rate of 6.10% and a balance of \$345,647.

Mr. Adams stated that the next lowest loan amount was around \$900,000 and those interest rates were below 3%. It was proposed to present a budget amendment at the next regular meeting on June 18<sup>th</sup> to pay off the two loans. He presented the recommended budget changes:
