High blood pressure can damage your heart and cause health problems if it stays high for a long time. High blood pressure usually has no warning signs, so many people don't realize they have it. There is only one way to tell if you have high blood pressure and that is by measuring it, which is quick and painless!



During the month of April, have your blood pressure checked twice a week. You can use your own cuff if you have it, or have it checked at one of the following places: the Health Department, DSS, Sylva and Cashiers Senior Centers, Justice Center, or the Cullowhee Recreation Center. Record your numbers below on each day that you have it checked.
