I wanted to request that we look at stain or paint for the DOA building.

When we spoke about it in the budget process it appeared only to be an aesthetic question but now that we have looked deeper and pressure washed I believe we need to have someone come and restrain all the wood on the building. I have included some photos of the wood and it shows some splitting and deterioration. I feel it is important to take care of this through a contractor because of the size of this job. Also, some of the beams are part of the load bearing structure for the building. The cost of this project would be between \$17,000 to \$18,500.
